



IMPLEMENTATION

A. Administration

The Redevelopment Department will administer the Anti-Graffiti Film Program.

B. Application

Applications for participation in the Anti-Graffiti Film Program must be obtained from and returned to the Redevelopment Department at City Hall located at 460 N. Euclid Avenue. Applications will be accepted on a first come first serve basis from eligible applicants consistent with funding availability.

C. Procedure

Once the eligible applicant has submitted an application and **received written approval** from the Redevelopment Department of acceptance to participate in the program, the applicant has 45 days to submit a legible paid invoice to the Department showing that the film has been applied. Once Department staff has confirmed that the work has been completed, the appropriate rebate amount will be processed for payment.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Downtown Anti-Graffiti Film Program has been established to provide financial assistance to property owners or tenants of commercial buildings located in the Town Center component area of the Merged Redevelopment Project Area to install anti-graffiti film on the ground-level glass windows or doors of their buildings that face a street (the “Eligible Glass Surface”).

ASSISTANCE TYPE

Applicants eligible for participation in the program may receive a rebate from the Upland Community Redevelopment Agency for up to 50% of the cost of placement of the anti-graffiti film on their Eligible Glass Surface or \$2.50 per square foot of Eligible Glass Surface, whichever is less. In order to assist as many businesses as possible, applicants are eligible for participation in the program not more than once per fiscal year.



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

A. Eligible Applicants

Eligible applicants are those that have a legal right of occupancy (property owner or tenant) to a commercial building located in the Town Center component area of the Merged Redevelopment Project Area who have not participated in the program within the fiscal year during which they seek assistance.

B. Eligible Reimbursement

Eligible reimbursements include the application of anti-graffiti film only. The Agency will not cover the cost of tinted or other such film unless it is also shown to be anti-graffiti. In order for an invoice to be eligible for reimbursement “anti-graffiti” must be stated under the work description and be submitted to the Agency within 45 days of the applicant receiving written notice of acceptance from the Redevelopment Department to participate in the program.

DISCLAIMER

In certain circumstances anti-graffiti cannot protect against damage caused by extreme etching and scratching of glass. Some tools used by etchers are sharp enough to puncture anti-graffiti film resulting in damage to the glass. The purpose of the Downtown Anti-Graffiti Film Program is to deter as much graffiti as possible and does not guarantee that damage will not occur to glass with anti-graffiti film. In such cases where glass with anti-graffiti film is damaged, the Agency is not responsible for replacement, correction or reimbursement of the damaged glass or anti-graffiti film.
