A. DECLARATION

This application is submitted pursuant to the Upland Anti-Graffiti Film Program ("Program") offered by the Upland Community Redevelopment Agency ("Agency") and as defined by the Program's policies. In applying for Program assistance, I completed the above information for the purpose of obtaining assistance. I certify under the penalty of perjury that all of the information is true, correct and complete and that I made no misrepresentations in the application or other documents, nor did I omit any pertinent information.

B. APPLICANT ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

It is expressly agreed and understood by the undersigned that:

1. The Program has been established to provide financial assistance to property owners or tenants of commercial buildings located in the Town Center component area of the Merged Redevelopment Project Area (the "Target Area") to install anti-graffiti film on the ground-level glass windows or doors of their buildings that face a street (the "Eligible Glass Surface").
2. Eligible Applicants are those that have a legal right of occupancy (property owner or tenant) to a commercial building located in the Target Area who have not participated in the program within the fiscal year during which they seek assistance.
3. Applicants eligible for participation in the program may receive a rebate from the Upland Community Redevelopment Agency for up to 50% of the cost of placement of the anti-graffiti film on their Eligible Glass Surfaces or \$2.50 per square foot of Eligible Glass Surface, whichever is less. Eligible Applicants are eligible for participation in the Program not more than once per fiscal year.
4. Eligible reimbursements include the application of anti-graffiti film only. The Agency will not cover the cost of tinted film or other such film unless it is also shown to be anti-graffiti. In order for an invoice to be eligible for reimbursement "anti-graffiti" must be stated under work description and be submitted to the Agency within 45

days of the applicant receiving written notice of acceptance from the Redevelopment Department to participate in the Program.

5. I am either the property owner or tenant for the property identified on the application and have a legal right to have anti-graffiti film applied to window glass on the property.
6. I will only be reimbursed for work performed on or after the date of the Agency's approval of this application.
7. In certain circumstances, anti-graffiti film cannot protect against damage caused by extreme etching and scratching of glass. Some tools used by etchers are sharp enough to puncture anti-graffiti film resulting in damage to the glass. The purpose of the Downtown Anti-Graffiti Film Program is to deter as much graffiti as possible and does not guarantee that damage will not occur to glass with anti-graffiti film. In such cases where glass with anti-graffiti film is damaged, the Agency is not responsible for replacement, correction or reimbursement of the damaged glass or anti-graffiti film. Further, I am solely responsible for arranging for the installation of the anti-graffiti film. The Agency's sole responsibility is to provide a financial payment pursuant to the Program. Therefore, as a condition of eligibility, I agree to indemnify, defend (upon request by Agency) and save harmless Agency, its elected and appointed officials, officers, agents and employees from and against any liability, expense, including defense costs and legal fees, and claims for damages of any nature whatsoever, including, but not limited to, bodily injury, death, personal injury, property damage, liens, liability or expense, arising from or connected with my participation in the Anti-Graffiti Film Program.
8. This application will only be deemed approved if it is counter signed by the Agency's representative.

C. RIGHT OF ENTRY

I hereby consent to allow authorized representatives of the Agency to enter my place of business, as identified above, for the purpose of inspecting and evaluating the area for which the anti-graffiti film is proposed to be and/or has been applied. This evaluation will be performed jointly by the undersigned and the representative(s) of the Agency.
